NOTES

1. Classification of Membership available on entry:
 - Ordinary Member - aged 23 and over – use of all Club facilities
 - Ordinary Member Off Peak - as above but restricted to 09.00–16.00 hours Mon – Fri and excluding weekends and Bank Holidays.
 - Youth Member - aged 18–22 - use of all Club facilities
 - Junior Member - aged 15-17 – use of rowing, tennis and squash facilities
 - Juvenile Member - aged under 15 – use of rowing, tennis and squash facilities 9am to 9 pm daily
 - Associate - aged 18 – 60 – social facilities only
 - Senior Associate - aged over 60 – social facilities only

Family Group - up to 2 children under the age of 15 years receive membership free of charge when both parents are Ordinary Members
2. The applicant must be known to the Proposer. Proposer and Seconder must be Life, Senior Ordinary, Ordinary or Youth Members. Where necessary the Club Manager will arrange an interview with Officers.
3. Enter date of proposal. Note that application must be lodged with the Club Manager by 10 am on the 1st Monday of a month for election to take place the following month.
4. Endorsement is required by a Council or Committee Member if the Proposer or Seconder is not such a Member. The Proposer must arrange for such endorsement.
5. Entrance fee or deposit must accompany application. Subscriptions are payable on confirmation of election. Details of such are available at reception.
6. On accepting membership the applicant agrees to pay subscriptions for a 12 month period either in advance or by direct debit payments. This membership is renewable annually and may not be terminated until the 12 month period is completed.
