

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The tournament is sanctioned by Tennis Ireland and will be held under the Rules of Tennis and the Rules, Regulations and code of conduct of Tennis Ireland. Entrants must also adhere to the rules of the Belfast Boat Club.
2. Entries with fees should be sent to the Tournament Secretary, Belfast Boat Club, 12 Lockview Road, Belfast, BT9 5FJ. Entrants must give precedence to tournament matches over any other competition.
3. Belfast Boat Club has a dress code of recognised tennis clothing. T-shirts, running shorts, football & rugby shirts etc are not permitted.
4. All events will be played as best of 3 tie break sets with a champions tie break as the third set.
5. Entrants must agree on request to act as umpires or linespersons.
6. Play will commence at 6pm on Friday 23rd March 2018 (or 11am if necessary and players have indicated availability as such at time of entry) & from 10am on the following 2 days. Players must report to the referees desk 15 minutes before the time when scheduled to play. Failure to do so may result in a player being scratched.
7. Subject to weather conditions the dome covered artificial grass courts at Belfast Boat Club will be used. However players must be prepared to play on courts other than these which may include artificial grass courts at another site and / or outdoor artificial grass courts.
8. Warm up times on court are limited to a maximum of 5 minutes. Any player failing to play when called upon to do so by an official is liable to be scratched.
9. Responsibility for finding out match times rests with the players. The order of play for the following day will be available on the website – www.belfastboatclub.com from 9pm each evening. If you do not have access to the website the order of play will be available by calling reception.
10. ITF Approved tennis balls will be used.
11. The minimum number of players (*or pairs for a doubles event*) is 4. Where an event has less than 4 players or pairs the event in question will be combined with a lower age group.
12. No complaint in connection with the conduct of the tournament will be entertained unless made in accordance with 3.1.10.1 of the Regulations for the code of Official Tournaments approved by Tennis Ireland.
13. Players may be asked to undergo a drugs test.
14. Closing date for entries is 10pm on Sunday 18th March 2018.
15. The maximum permitted entry is 2 events.
16. Entry fees must be paid before you play your first match.
17. Restaurant facilities will be available during the tournament.
18. Entrants must attain the stipulated age by 31st December 2018.
