CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The tournament is sanctioned by Tennis Ireland and will be held under the Rules of Tennis and the Rules, Regulations and code of conduct of Tennis Ireland. Entrants must also adhere to the rules of the Belfast Boat Club
2. Entries with fees should be sent to the Tournament Secretary, Belfast Boat Club, 12 Lockview Road, Belfast, BT9 5FJ. Entrants must give precedence to tournament matches over any other competition.
3. Belfast Boat Club has a dress code of recognised tennis clothing. T-shirts, running shorts, football & rugby shirts etc are not permitted.
4. In all events tie breaks will operate in all three sets except as below.
5. Entrants must agree on request to act as umpires or linespersons.
6. Play will commence at 11am on Sunday 17th June 2018 & from 5.30pm Mon - Friday. Players must report to the referees desk 15 minutes before the time when scheduled to play. Failure to do so may result in a player being scratched.
7. Warm up times on court are limited to a maximum of 5 minutes. Any player failing to play when called upon to do so by an official is liable to be scratched.
8. Responsibility for finding out match times rests with the players. The order of play for the following day will be available on the website – www.belfastboatclub.com from 10.30pm each evening. If you do not have access to the website the order of play will be available by calling reception from 10am on the day of play.
9. Slazenger tennis balls will be used.
10. An event may not be held if there are insufficient entries.
11. Players in events 11 – 15 must be a minimum of 18 years old by 1st September 2018.
12. No complaint in connection with the conduct of the tournament will be entertained unless made in accordance with 3.1.10.1 of the Regulations for the code of Official Tournaments approved by Tennis Ireland.
13. All players must be available on finals day if required. Prize money for Championship events will only be awarded during the official prize giving following conclusion of play on finals day. Prize money for championship events 1 – 5 will be forfeited if players are not present at the prize giving.
14. Players may be asked to undergo a drugs test
15. Closing date for entries is 11pm on Tuesday 12th June 2018
16. The maximum permitted entry is 3 events – 1 singles, 1 doubles & 1 mixed.
17. Entry fees must be paid before you play your first match.
